

Rules for exhibitions

With FIAP/PSA/RPS patronage

With PhotExCreator, click “Update exhibition data” and select the Web tab. Just click the button marked “Set the options required for PSA, FIAP and/or RPS patronage”. This will cause the approved text for the rules to be shown along with a mandatory tick box to for the entrant to agree to abide by them, and also set the option for oversized images to “Reject”

Without FIAP/PSA/RPS patronage

With PhotExCreator, click “Update exhibition data” and select the Web tab...



1. Do not click this
2. Add the rules – see below
3. Tick this
4. Set this to the exhibition requirements – “Ask” allows the entrant to choose to let the software resize oversized images, “Reject” rejects the upload, forcing the entrant to change and resubmit the image.

Clicking “Change” at 2 above shows this page...
